



## Preschool At Home Learning Plan

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### Purpose

While the Early Childhood Department promotes a curriculum of discovery and experiential learning, we recognize that it may become necessary to ensure that our students are served in the safety of their homes and therefore have developed a plan keeping developmental needs in mind. The following measures will be enacted in the event that children need to learn from home:

### Key Descriptors

- Individual pencil boxes with school supplies will be sent home with each child to ensure needed materials are on hand in the home (crayons, pencils, glue, scissors)
- Packets of take home activities will be sent home with each student
  - Packets will also be available online for any family who prefers this format, or any family who was unable to pick up materials.
  - Activities will address math, literacy and social-emotional development
- Workbooks with early reading and math activities have been ordered and will be distributed by ECE upon arrival
- Parents will receive communication from their child's teachers through classroom newsletters, phone calls, and Google Meets online conferences
  - ECE will suggest family activities addressing physical, language and cognitive development
- Early Childhood Department is working on procuring iPads and Apps to supplement the TS Gold domains that will eventually be distributed to teachers and students
  - Early Childhood Department will develop and provide training in the effective use of iPads as educational tools for early learners
