## Return to School Plan

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The District 60 Board of Education has approved these Re-Entry plans: These are the most current models for the start of school this Fall 2020. All plans must meet state and local mandates specific to COVID -19 operations. These plans are subject to change based on the most current rules and regulations. Depending on orders and guidelines, D60 may utilize more than one plan based on the grade level and school enrollment size

### **1** IN-PERSON LEARNING

**K- 5 students will begin school as traditionally as possible adhering to recommended health and safety guidelines. Classes will be held Mon-Thurs. at normal scheduled times: 7:45- 3:05.**

- Health screenings of students, temperature checks, wearing of masks are expected, as required by State Mandate, social distancing in the school and classrooms, contact tracing and use of PPE.
- Students will line up and enter the classroom through classroom exterior door for health screening. Students arriving after 7:50 must enter through the front office for health screening.
- Instruction will continue to occur in cohort (grade level classroom) groups as much as possible. There will be no large group or cross cohort (grade level) interactions.
- All students will be issued a device to be used at school and/or at home for learning.
- Classrooms will have adequate supplies to support healthy hygiene behavior, including soap, paper towels, and hand sanitizer, etc.
- Signs will be posted on how to stop the spread of COVID-19, properly wash hands, promote everyday protective measures, and properly wear a required face covering.

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- Everyone is asked to implement physical distancing of 3 to 6 feet at all times and to the greatest degree, wherever and whenever possible.
  - Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned, sanitized, and disinfected multiple times per day.
  - When shared objects are required, they will be cleaned between use.
  - Education tools will be disinfected and sanitized regularly.
  - Adequate supplies will be provided and ensured to minimize sharing of high-touch materials.
  - Each child's belongings will be kept separately in individually labeled storage containers, cubbies, or taken home to be cleaned each day.
  - Hallways will be divided to accommodate flow of traffic on each side of the hallway.
  - Everyone is required to wear facial coverings in classrooms, hallways, entering and exiting the building.
  - Breakfast and lunch options will be provided. Students could possibly eat outdoors or socially distanced in cafeteria.
  - Students will generally attend lunch in grade-level cohorts.
  - While students will be allowed to bring their lunch, all social events such as parties, large gatherings, and any social events are suspended. Therefore no outside food for such events will be allowed in the building.
  - Cafeteria tables will be cleaned and sanitized between lunch periods.
  - Lunch tables will be arranged to encourage social distancing.
  - Recess will take place outside as weather permits. Playground equipment may be used by small cohorts of students as long as they wash their hands upon returning to school. Recess may also be used as a mask break as long as students are socially distanced. All equipment will be sanitized after use.
  - Students will be required to wear masks whenever and wherever possible. All facial coverings must be appropriate for the school environment with no graphics or verbiage violating school and district dress code policy.
  - All Belmont Families are required to wear a mask before and after school while on school property.
  - All visitors and volunteers at the building are suspended at this time. Parents dropping off and picking up students are required to wear a mask and remain at the front office.

## **2** FULL REMOTE LEARNING

**Due to increased wide-spread transmission of COVID-19 in the local community or school, D60 may transition into a full remote learning model.**

- District Online Program will utilize District Adopted Curriculum through Google Classroom and Nearpod as the instructional platforms to carry out remote learning.
- All students will be provided a device for remote learning.
- Meals will be provided through D60 Nutrition Services (details pending)
- Students with Special Services will be provided access for in-person learning in small groups as needed.
