Dear Parents/Guardians,

Well our first quarter is under our belt and we are operating with a fluctuating enrollment of 295-307 students. Our staff continues to work diligently to provide your child with a quality education. We still need your assistance in communicating to your child the importance of returning electronic devices with chargers, completed homework assignments, planners being signed, daily attendance, following all school rules and participating in all school and class activities. Please remember we are still reaching out to our parents who may have missed your child(s) Parent Teacher Conference, this is an effective way of communication and as a school we strive for 100% completion. It is imperative that we are able to share the progress of your child.

### **ATTENDANCE**

It is imperative that we as a TEAM continue to strive for our goal of 95 % daily attendance. Our attendance for the month of October was 93.37%. We are aware that illnesses will occur and that in the best interest of all students there will be times that keeping your son/daughter at home is necessary, but please make an effort to have your child attend. Students can only learn if they are in attendance and are allowed to be exposed to instruction, which increases student achievement. **Please make sure that if your son/daughter is ill that you call the office by 9:30 am each day they are absent. Failure to do so will result in an unexcused absence.** We would like to welcome Mr. Jason Torres, our new Community Advocate to our TEAM. For the first quarter we would like to report a 88.75 % attendance rate. Keep up the great work and remember our goal is 95 % for monthly attendance. **Kudos to our fifth grade students. They had a 90.27% attendance rate!**

### **PARENT/GUARDIAN VISITATION**

Please continue to assist us in making sure our school is a safe environment by checking in with the office and filling out the log as well as getting your visitor's pass. We want to assure our students that everyone in the building is accounted for and encourage visitors/volunteers, please make sure that you and your child comply with CDC and are wearing a mask each day while entering the building.

### **SCHOOL HOURS**

**We need your help!** We have no morning supervision on the school grounds prior to 7:40 a.m. Staff members on duty will direct our students to line up at their designated grade level areas and students are not to be playing on the equipment.

### **PARENT DROP OFF AND PICKUP**

Please continue to assist us in our efforts of providing our students with a safe pathway to school. We ask that you utilize 9<sup>th</sup> street heading east as your drop off and pick up, utilizing our new loop and utilize 10<sup>th</sup> street heading east as your drop off and pick up areas. We are asking for your assistance if you are using 10th street as your pick up and drop off area. Please do not double park, you can circle around toward 9th street and either utilize our loop or circle around back to 10th. **Our police department will patrol school zone areas and will strictly enforce all traffic laws.**
